

Mulligan's Policies and Dress Code

No gang or motorcycle colors (Vests).

Hats

- Hats are allowed.
- Hoods are not permitted to be worn inside.
- No brimless headwear is allowed (bandanas, skullcaps, etc.).

Shirts

- No extra long shirts (that hang below pant pockets).
- No plain white tee shirts (When worn in groups)
- No shirts that the management considers vulgar, offensive, or otherwise likely to cause a disturbance.
- Shirts must remain on at all times.

Pants

- No extra long shorts (that fall below mid calf).
- No excessively low or baggy pants such that a person's undergarments or butt is exposed.

Footwear

- Footwear must be worn at all times.
- No baseball, softball, golf, or football cleats.

Bags / Backpacks - (To ensure customer and staff safety)

- No large bags
- All bags that are allowed, but deemed questionable, are subject to search prior to entering the establishment. However, individuals are free to refuse the bag search and enter the establishment without the questionable bag.

Miscellaneous and Under 21 guest policies

- Clothing must not be excessively torn, dirty, tattered, or emit an unpleasant odor.
- No laser pointers.
- No bicycle chains or locks.
- No outside food or beverages.
- No horns, or other objects likely to cause a disturbance in the establishment.
- Management has the right to deny admission to anyone suspected to be intoxicated or deemed likely to cause a disturbance.
- Under 21 guests are permitted with an adult over the age of 25 and must exit prior to 10 PM.
- At no time is an under age 21 guest permitted to taste or consume alcohol.
- All guests over the age of 21 are required to show valid ID including drivers license, state identification card, military ID, or passport.
